Focus: As baptized children who are "walking wet," tweens have the marvelous opportunity to put their faith into words as they journey together with mentor adults during their sixth grade year. Studying the scriptures, learning to live out their faith in word and deed, and accepting the challenge of living as faithful disciples provide the foundation for a lifetime of faithfulness to God.

Tweens conclude their 3-year Confirmation Journey with a study of the creeds and confessions of the PC(USA) and an opportunity to develop their own **Statement of Faith**.

Tweens make **Blessing Bowls** as part of their Confirmation Retreat and learn about the spiritual practice of counting blessings using their faith stones.

Parents serve as an integral part of this final year of Confirmation through Sunday School small groups, trips, special events, and the weekend retreat.
