Parent Tip:

Just as you are coaching and teaching your child to use manners and learn new words, you are their worship coach. Robbie Castleman says, "Children learn by participation, practice and patience." You are showing them through example and reminders what it means to worship God in our worship spaces. Let your child know why you choose to come to worship. Talk about your favorite part of worship. Invite them to share what they heard or liked about today's time of worship. They may surprise you on what they heard. Encourage them to watch what is happening and draw their attention to meaningful movement during the service, including watching for when candles are lit, when the pastor arrives, where the choir is singing from, etc. *Learning to keep the Lord's Day holy is a lifetime gift you are giving your child!*
